

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the  
Northwest Regional Lancaster County Police Commission  
Held on June 26, 2007**

1. David W. Sweigart, III called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. in the Mount Joy Township Municipal Building at 159 Merts Drive, Elizabethtown, PA 17022. Mr. Speers led the pledge of allegiance.
2. Roll call: Present – Gerald G. Cole, Stephen J. Speers, Roger M. Snyder, David W. Sweigart, III and Charles A. Tupper.

4. Consent Calendar:

As the cruiser was sitting at the scene with the officer in the vehicle it was hit from behind by a truck that was traveling to fast. It was foggy at the time. Mr. Cole stated the Mount Joy Township Board of Supervisors requested additional police presence in the area of Cloverleaf Road and the landfill.
