Police Activity from 7 March 2008 to 9 March 2008

Shortly after 10:00 AM on Friday, 7 March 2008, Officers from the NWRPD responded to the 9200 block of Elizabethtown Rd. for a report of trespassing. Officers investigating the complaint located a 17 year old juvenile inside a vacant building in the 9200 block of Elizabethtown Rd. that was posted against trespassing. As a result of the investigation, Lt. Carl Steinhart will be filing a summary Trespassing citation against the juvenile. The juvenile was released to Elizabethtown High School officials.



On Friday, 7 March 2008, a concerned citizen reported finding a partial vehicle bumper with an Ontario, Canada Providence registration plate attached. The bumper and registration plate were found along the roadside of SR 283 in the vicinity of the Cloverleaf Rd. exit. NWRPD is asking anyone with information regarding this incident to contact the police department at 717-367-8481.



During the late afternoon hours of Saturday, 8 March 2008, officers from the NWRPD responded to a vehicle accident that was reported by a West Donegal Township employee. On arrival at the scene in the area of Maytown Rd. and West Ridge Rd., Lt. Mark Mayberry located a vehicle stuck off the roadway. The vehicle operator indicated to Lt. Mayberry that he lost control of his vehicle when he took evasive action to avoid colliding with an oncoming vehicle that had crossed the center of the roadway into his traffic lane.

While investigating the incident, Lt. Mayberry discovered that the vehicle operator, Daniel Alexander Brown M/28 YOA of Maytown, PA was wanted on an outstanding bench warrant for a probation violation. Brown was arrested on the outstanding bench warrant and turned over to the Lancaster County Sheriff's Department.
