The Northwest Regional Police are investigating a burglary and theft of copper pipes from two residences in the 300 block of Cloverleaf Rd. in Mt. Joy Township. Sometime between 31 July 2008 and 14 August 2008, unknown suspects forced their way into two unoccupied residences in the 300 block of Cloverleaf Rd. The suspects removed copper piping from the building heating systems.

The Northwest Regional Police are investigating the theft of street and traffic control signs from roadways in W. Donegal Township. The W. Donegal Twp. Roadmaster reported that between 8 August and 11 August 2008 unknown suspects removed (4) street signs from the township roads. Two street signs each for Foreman Rd. and Anchor Rd. were taken. The signs have a green background and white lettering and are valued at \$16.00 each. In addition to the street signs, a Stop sign and 2 inch metal post were taken. The stop sign is valued at \$60.00 and the post at \$29.00.
