Aggressive Drivers Beware Area Police Continue Enforcement Efforts

Lancaster County, Pa – As part of Pennsylvania’s ongoing Drive Safe Pa campaign to improve highway safety, law enforcement in the region is targeting aggressive drivers.

The Northwest Lancaster County Regional Police Department recently conducted aggressive driving enforcement along Route 283 and Route 743, on 27 March 2009. During that period officers issued 27 citations, 25 speeding and 2 other violations. Of the 25 speeding citations three of the violators were traveling over 100 MPH, with a top speed being 105 MPH.

Aggressive driving includes such risky behaviors as speeding, red light running, tailgating, or making frequent and careless lane changes.

Motorists are reminded the Northwest Lancaster County Regional Police Department will continue to conduct enforcement details throughout Mount Joy Township and West Donegal Township. The best way to avoid being issued a traffic citation is to obey all traffic laws. Penn DOT reminds motorists to “Slow Down, Save a Life”. The life you save could be your own.

Drive Safe PA urges motorists to always avoid life-threatening driving behaviors like aggressive driving, not wearing seat belts or driving while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
