At 4:25 PM on Monday, October 19, 2009, the Northwest Regional Police responded to the 400 block of West Ridge Rd. in West Donegal Township, for a report of a pedestrian struck by a motor vehicle. It was reported that the pedestrian had been walking along the roadway when struck. On the arrival of responding officers, they found, Ellen Sundy, 73 years old, conscious but suffering from multiple injuries. Ms. Sundy is a resident of West Ridge Rd.

The investigation has determined that a 1997 Honda Civic was traveling (SW) in the 400 block of West Ridge Rd. when it left the (NW) side of the roadway striking the pedestrian and a mail box. Both Ms. Sundy and the driver of the vehicle, Carissa Stoner, 18 years old, were transported to the Hershey Medical Center by the Northwest Emergency Medical Services ambulance. The pedestrian, Ellen Sundy, was admitted to the hospital and the driver, Carissa Stoner, a West Donegal Township resident, was treated and released.

The investigation is being conducted by Officer Ken Whitebread of the Northwest Regional Police. The Lancaster County Northwest Crash Team is assisting with the investigation.
