The Northwest Regional Police are conducting a Recklessly Endangering investigation due a dangerous incident that occurred at approximately 7:15 PM on Saturday evening, 29 May 2010. The incident occurred in the area of Elizabethtown Rd. and Ridgeview Road South in Mount Joy Township.

The victim, a 50 YOA, resident of Prospect Rd., Elizabethtown, was riding her motorcycle on Elizabethtown Rd. As she was approaching Ridgeview Road South, a younger looking, white, male threw fireworks out the rear flip up window of a dark colored Sports Utility Vehicle. The fireworks exploded directly in front of the victim's motorcycle causing her to lose control from being startled and suffering temporary vision impairment. When the victim attempted to evade the exploding device her motorcycle went off the roadway and turned onto its side. The victim suffered minor injuries to her right arm and damage to her motorcycle.
